







## Long term growth patterns






### GDP per sector, 2003






## GDP according to sector, average annual % growth rate, 1990-2003





### FDI inward stock as percentage of GDP








# High-technology exports in percent of manufactured exports, 2000-2003, percent


#### Patents to EPO & USPTO, relative to population, 2003



### R&D in the OECD and non-OECD area, GERD in million USD, 2003







# Growth of R&D expenditure, annual average growth rate 1991-2001, percent




# Percentage of active population engaged in starting new firms, 2003






## Gap in the form of lacking seed funding






### Social trust ranking
